Definitions •Complicated grief •Intensified and prolonged grief that results in severe impairment in functioning (Weaver, 2010) •Chronic grief, exaggerated grief •Bereavement exclusion for major depressive disorder (APA, 2013) •Clinicians can diagnose MDD after the loss of a loved one, previously not allowed even though symptoms paralleled MDD
